



BCA POLICY 1 - BCA PENNANT COMMITTEE

AREAS OF RESPONSIBILITY

Updated - May 2017

Responsibilities:

- Enforcing and implementing the current BCA rules as approved from year to year
- Support turf cricket for the top level Senior & Junior grades in the BCA
- Approval of season fixtures and team grading
- Approval of clearances
- Approval of Age Exemptions in Junior Grades
- Determine player eligibility.
- Approval of player movement between grades.
- Approval of Ground allocations
- Determine pitch suitability
- Determine if play is possible due to inclement weather conditions. E.g. Heat (40 degrees) or too wet. (in consultation with other members of the Pennant Committee)
- Adjudicate on disputes – clearances, match results, fixtures etc
- Report directly to the BCA Board through representation at Board level
- Issue penalties and fines for a variety of breaches by Clubs and officials.
- Ensuring the Pennant Committee contact phone is manned during scheduled play times.
- Areas of Responsibilities of the Committee Members:
 - Grounds
 - Age Exemptions
 - Weather & Ground Conditions
 - Board Information
 - Rules and Regulations
 - Umpires

Chairperson's Additional Responsibilities:

- A director on the Board of the BCA
- Consult members of the Pennant Committee for decisions conditions of play. Eg. Heat & wet weather.
- Undertake allocated responsibilities as part of the Ballarat Cricket Association Board.
- Responsible for tabling the Pennant Committee reports at Board meetings.
- Report back from Board Meetings to the Pennant Committee.
